The basket raffle was ready to go with its 40 baskets. The hot dogs were on the grill, the 50/50 tickets were ready to be sold. We just needed the cars.


Well, the turnout was not as we expected, but the 43 cars and the owners that were not scared off because of the weather report, had a good time.
