SPRING TECH TIP

It's spring finally, and if you haven't yet gotten your Corvette out of winter storage, you have to at least be thinking about it. So just a few reminders:

- Make sure the battery has a full charge. Is your battery more than four years old? Mine was 5 and it was done. I did manage to jump start it. Newer Corvettes do some weird things when the battery dies. Do you know how to open the doors, trunk, or hood if the battery is completely dead? Don't expect the person that arrives from AAA or whoever you call for help to know. And if you have a C8, the transmission is locked in park with a dead battery and the car can't be moved without wheel dollies {now were having fun).
- Some people like to put a few extra pounds of air in the tires when they store their car. Others store them with normal pressure. Whatever the case, check tire pressure and correct if necessary.
- Did you put moth balls in the engine compartment? Don't forget to remove.
- Owners of C5s to C8s will have less than 1/4 of a tank of fuel (that's what you should have done!). So fill the tank with a tier one fuel. In our area that would be primarily Mobil, Citco, or Marathon. Sunoco still is not on the list after being removed when covid started.
- If you prefer you can use cheaper fuel and add your own additive. But remember fuel injectors need proper care. What do they say, "pay me now or pay me later"? GM recommends Techron Concentrate Plus as an additive. And by the way, GM warns to stay away from Seafoam as an additive. It apparently is not compatible with GM sensors.

So do the right thing and enjoy the Corvette weather and remember to wave.

National Council of Corvette Clubs (NCCC) Q & A

Bob Metz - Governor for NCCC

- Q: What if the club participates in a parade or car show they are not hosting? Are waivers required?
- A: If your Club attends a parade as an Official Club Organized event for your club, no matter who is hosting
- it. You must have signed waivers. Car Shows do not require waivers.
- Q: How long should the original waiver be kept.
 - 1. All original waivers both Adult & Minor are to be kept by the Host Club for two (2) years.
 - 2. If a reportable incident occurs at an event, then the original signed waiver for the Adult/s or Minor/s will be sent immediately to the current NCCC Business Manager. He/she will retain those waivers in the NCCC Claims Document File until the claim/s have been settled. Then the file will be kept in the NCCC Business Managers storage area provided by NCCC.

NCCC Notice of Claim Form and Accident Claim Form:

Reportable Incidents: Any time an incident occurs at an NCCC Event whether it is sanctioned or not, it is to be immediately notified per the Notification process identified below.

A NCCC Notice of Claim Form is to be filled out within 72 hours of the incident. This is a report of the incident only. You are not to wait to see if an actual claim is being filled. If a claim is being filled, you will notify both our current NCCC Insurance Agent and the current NCCC Business Manager of the claim. The NCCC Insurance Agent will notify you whether to fill out the Accident Claim Form or not.

Forms: There are two types of forms when an incident occurs:

- **1. NCCC Notice of Claim Form**: This form has to be filled out within 72 hours of the incident, along with the immediate notifications as described below.
- 2. Accident Claim Form: This form will be filled out when advised by Legacy Ins.

Notification: When an incident arises at an event/function, both Brian Gries or Tim Gries at Legacy Insurance and the current NCCC Business Manager must be notified immediately by phone message or email regarding any accident whether a claim is filed or not.

Incident Notification form & Claim Submission: The NCCC Notice of Claim Form must be submitted to Legacy Insurance within 72 hours of the incident or the claim may not be honored. Legacy Insurance will notify the person submitting the NCCC Notice of Claim Form if and when the Accident Claim Form needs to be filled out.

NCCC Notice of Claim Form and Accident Claim Form availability: Both current forms are available on the NCCC Website. Scroll to Insurance Information and then scroll to Insurance Claim Forms.
